\*Each day read for 20 minutes

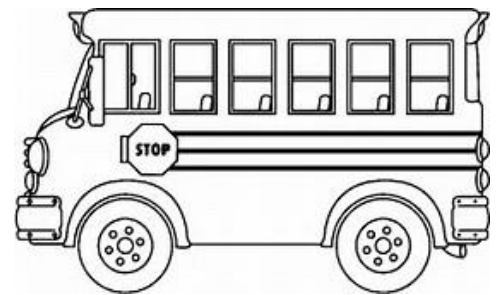
**Monday:** Choose a chapter from your book and illustrate it.
